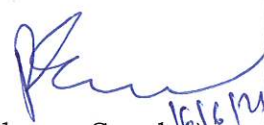

Attention is invited to all the eligible candidates that Competitive Written Examination will be held on **28.06.2026 (Sunday)** as notified already vide Notice dated 29.05.2026, the eligible candidates are required to download the Admit Card from CSIR-IICT website and produce the same at the examination venue. The link for downloading the Admit Card is available with the notice (<https://www.iict.res.in/CAREERS>).

The instructions for PwBD candidates are attached as Annexure I. PwBD candidates eligible to avail the facility of a scribe and or/ compensatory time (20 minutes per hour) must submit a certificate stating that the concerned person has a physical limitation to write from Competent Medical Authority as prescribed under rules and in accordance with the prescribed proformas (Annexure II). The said certificate is to be emailed (rectt@csiriict.in) to the office on or before 21.06.2026, further to which no requests shall be entertained. The candidates who have already submitted their request for availing the facility of scribe need not re-submit the request.

The scribe will be provided by CSIR-IICT as per government guidelines and requests for own scribe will not be accepted.

The candidates are requested to visit CSIR-IICT website regularly for any further updates and keep their registered e-mail I.D. active.

Instructions for PwBD Candidates:

- (i) In case of persons with benchmark disabilities in the category of blindness, locomotor disability (both arms affected-BA) and cerebral palsy, the facility of scribe for competitive written examination is provided, if so desired by the candidate.
- (ii) For the remaining persons with benchmark disabilities, the provision of scribe will be available on production of a certificate to the effect that the person concerned has physical limitation to write and scribe is essential to write examination on his/her behalf, from the Chief Medical Officer/ Civil Surgeon/Medical Superintendent of a Government Health Care Institution as per Annexure enclosed.
- (iii) A compensatory time of 20 minutes per hour of examination will be provided to the persons who are allowed use of scribe as described at Para (i) & (ii). The candidates referred at Para (i) & (ii) who are eligible for use of scribe but not availing the facility of scribe will also be given compensatory time of 20 minutes per hour of examination.
- (iv) No attendant other than the scribe for eligible candidates will be allowed inside the examination hall.
