In continuation to CSIR-IICT Notice dated 14.10.2025, it is hereby informed that the Trade/ Skill Tests for the post codes CHEM-01 (Chemical Engineering), ELEC-02 [Engineering Services (Electrical)], MECH-03 [Engineering Services (Mechanical)], CIVL-04 [Engineering Services (Civil)], COMP-07 (Computer Services) & INMS-09 (Information Management Services) were conducted at CSIR-IICT premises during 27.10.2025 to 31.10.2025.

<b>Medium of Questions</b>	The questions will be set both in English and Hindi except the questions on English Language.
<b>Standard of exam</b>	Diploma/ Graduation Level (based on the advertised qualification of the post)
<b>Total No. of Questions</b>	200
<b>Total Time Allotted</b>	3 hours

*There will be three papers (Paper-I, Paper-II, Paper-III). Paper-II & Paper-III will be evaluated only for those candidates who secure the minimum threshold marks (to be determined by the Selection Committee) in the Paper-I. The Final merit list will be prepared only on the basis of the marks obtained by the candidates in Paper-II & III.*

The candidature of the candidate for Competitive Written Examination is provisional and is subject to verification of all essential requirements/ documents. At any stage of the recruitment process, if it is found that Applicant has furnished wrong information or does not meet the essential qualification/ criteria or the candidate indulges in any canvassing in any manner in support of his/ her candidature, such candidate's candidature will be cancelled without any further notice.

In this regard, the eligible candidates are required to download the admit card to appear for the Competitive Written Examination from CSIR-IICT website prior to one week before the exam, which will be notified in due course. In any circumstances request from candidates for change of date of examination will not be entertained.
