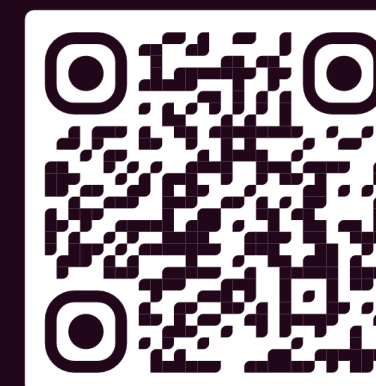

By Air: Hyderabad is well connected by air through Rajiv Gandhi International Airport (RGIA), located ~35 km from CSIR-IICT.
By Train: CSIR-IICT is conveniently accessible from the major railway stations in Hyderabad:
Secunderabad Railway Station – ~6 km
Kacheguda Railway Station – ~7 km
Hyderabad Deccan (Nampally) Railway Station – ~9 km
Charlapally Railway Terminal – ~10 km
By Road: Hyderabad has excellent road connectivity with major cities across Telangana and neighbouring states. CSIR-IICT, located at Tarnaka, Hyderabad, can be easily reached by taxis, buses, and other local transport.

Places to Visit near Hyderabad

- **Charminar** – The iconic symbol of Hyderabad and a historic monument surrounded by the famous Laad Bazaar (known for bangles, jewellery, handicrafts).
- **Salar Jung Museum** – One of India’s largest museums, an extensive collection of art, antiques, and historical artefacts.
- **Chowmahalla Palace** – A magnificent palace complex showcasing the royal heritage and grandeur of the Nizams.
- **Golconda Fort** – A magnificent fort known for its architecture, rich history, and panoramic views of the city.
- **Qutb Shahi Tombs** – A historic complex featuring beautifully preserved Indo-Islamic architecture and royal tombs.
- **Hussain Sagar Lake** – A scenic lake featuring the iconic Buddha statue and beautiful views of Hyderabad.
- **Lumbini Park** – A scenic urban park near Hussain Sagar, known for its gardens, boating, and laser show.
- **Birla Mandir** – A beautiful hilltop temple dedicated to Lord Venkateswara, offering panoramic views of the city.
- **Birla Science Centre** – A popular educational destination featuring a science, planetarium, and archaeological museum.
- **Ramoji Film City (~30 km)** – A world-famous film studio complex offering film sets, entertainment attractions, gardens
- **Statue of Equality (~40 km)** – A major spiritual and architectural attraction featuring the impressive statue of Sri Ramanujacharya.
- **Nagarjuna Sagar Dam (~165 km)** – A major dam across the Krishna River and a popular sightseeing destination.



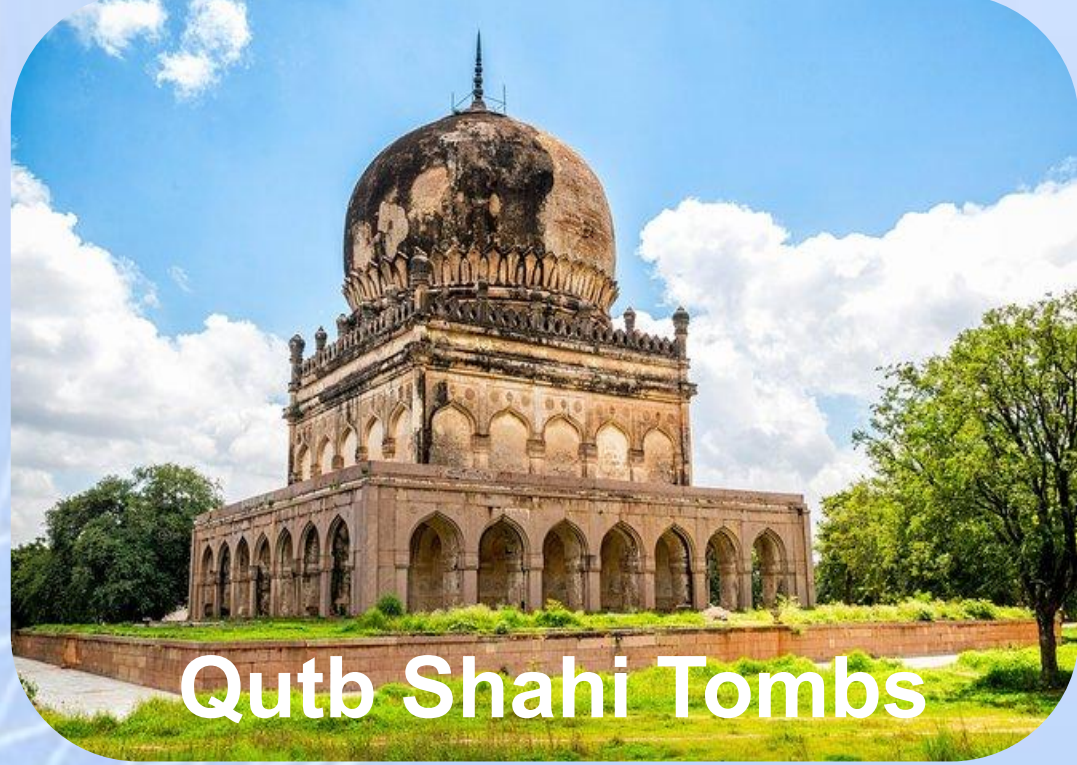

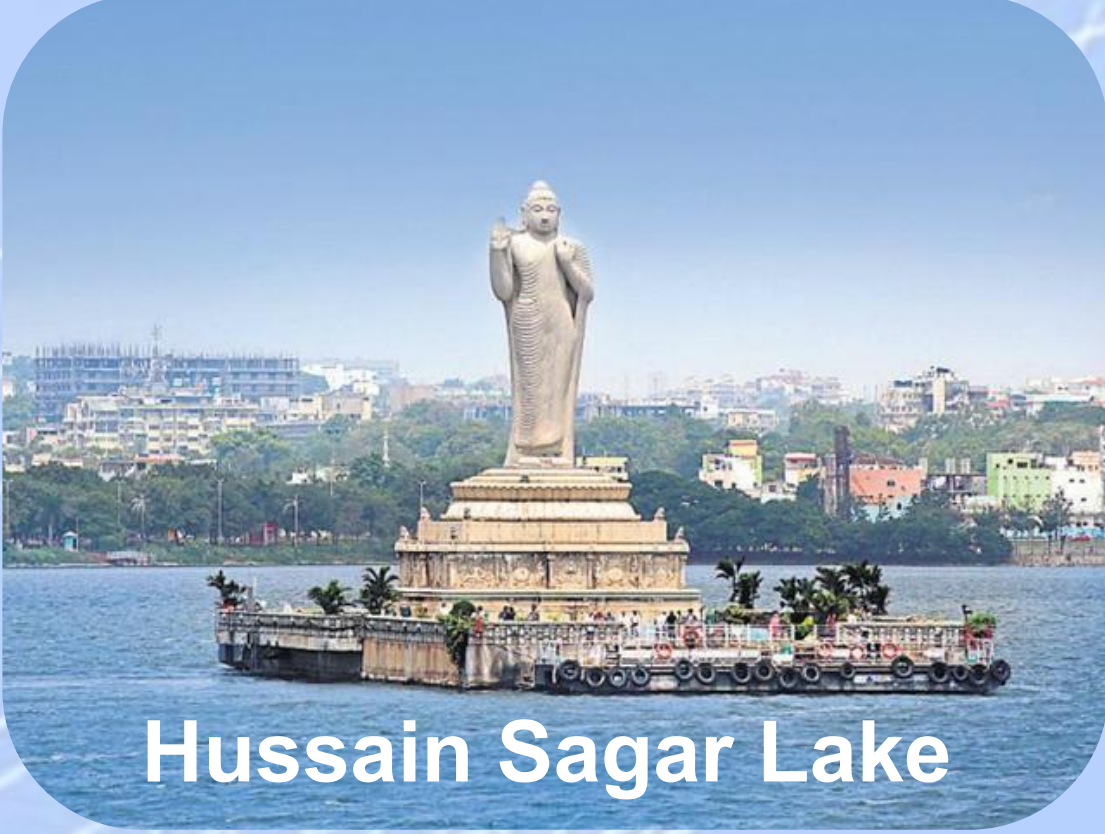

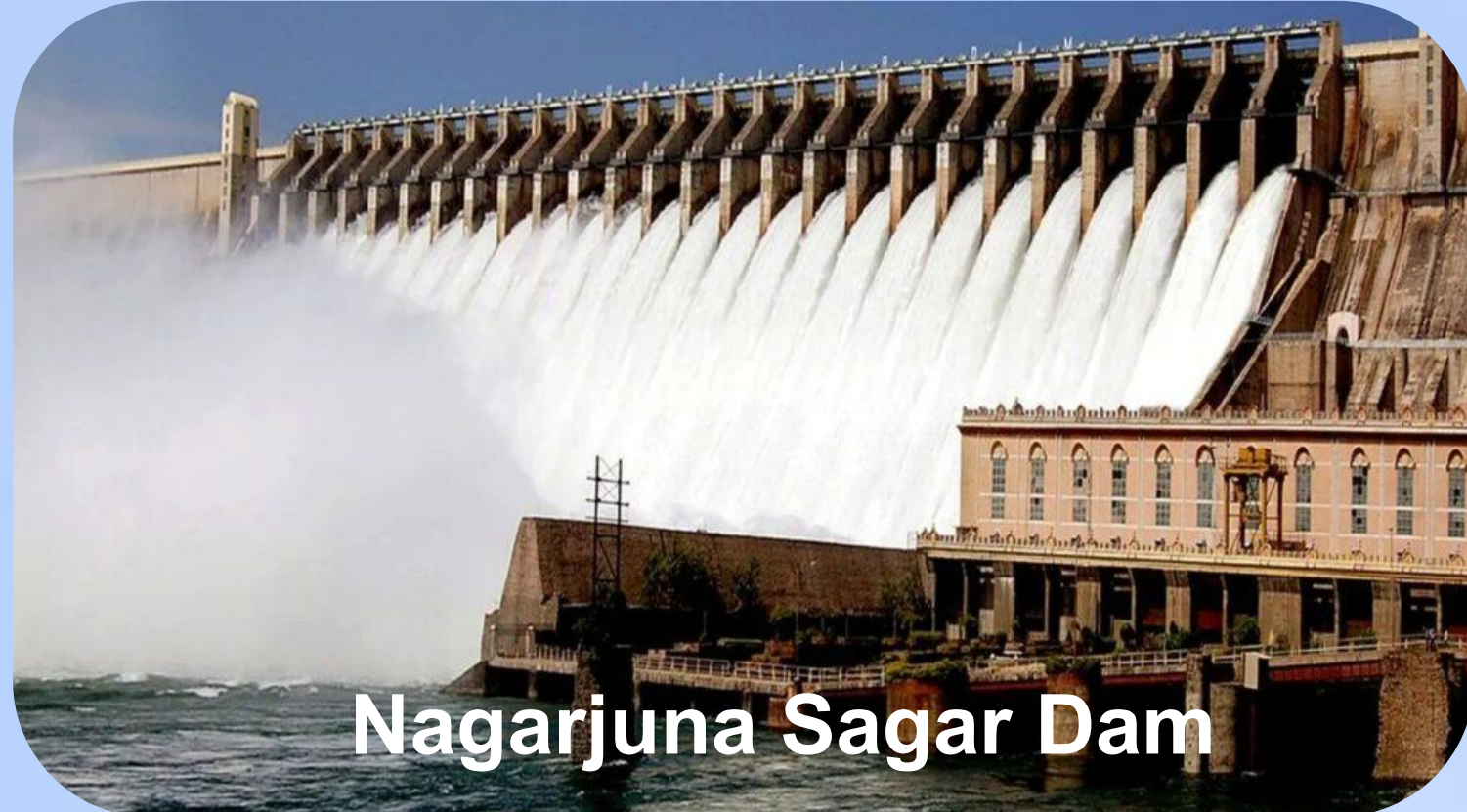
