1. The minimum average annual financial turnover of the bidder during the last three years, ending on 31st March of

previous financial year, should be as indicated above in the bid document. Documentary evidence in the form of cer Audited Balance Sheets of relevant periods or a certificate from the Chartered Accountant / Cost Accountant indicati turnover details for the relevant period shall be uploaded with the bid. In case the date of constitution / incorporation bidder is less than 3-year-old, the average turnover in respect of the completed financial years after the date of conshall be taken into account for this criteria.
